Bottega Gold wins Prosecco Masters award for second time

Bottega Gold has been awarded the top medal in the Prosecco Masterscompetition organised by the British magazine The Drinks Business.

Only four out of 160 submitted samples have achieved the top title.

The brand, supplied by Italian wine specialist Bottega, first won the prestigious Masters medal in 2015.

The jury, composed of Masters of Wine, Master Sommeliers and senior buyers, tasted approximately 160 wines on their style and price in a blind tasting session, which grants the anonymity of the tasted sample.


This medal (the 26th recognition achieved over the past 10 years) rewards the company's efforts to produce a premium Prosecco featuring the highest standard of quality in the category.

Bottega Gold is a Prosecco Brut sparkling wine, obtained by Glera grapes grown in the Valdobbiadene region. It is produced to order, to ensure maximum freshness.

In the winery, one single fermentation directly transforms the grape must into sparkling wine, hence preserving the delicate aromas of the grape: white flowers (acacia, wisteria, lily of the valley), green apple, pear and citrus.

Since 2001, Bottega has distributed the metallized bottles in over 120 countries worldwide.

Upcoming vintage releases are July 7, 2018 and October 27, 2018.



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
