Bottega S.p.A. is both a winery and a distillery that boasts a family history of three generations. The headquarters, immersed in the vineyards of Bibano di Godega, is located in a charming 16th century farmhouse, skilfully restored to preserve its architectural soul. The surrounding vineyards, cultivated according to organic farming principles, are part of the Prosecco DOC area and represent the green heart of the company. Bottega produces and distributes quality products worldwide. The range extends from single-varietal grappas to aged grappas, from Limoncino to creamy liqueurs, to the great red wines produced in the Valgatarà cellar in the heart of Valpolicella and in the Tuscan cellars of Montalcino and Chianti. Prosecco, the flagship wine of the company, is an ambassador of a refined and convivial Italian lifestyle.



The tour begins with a warm welcome toast in the lounge with fireplace, an intimate and cosy setting.



From here, one crosses the vineyards to reach the production area, where it is possible to closely observe the processing stages and taste fermenting products, such as sparkling wines. The Bottega oenologists accompany guests in a fascinating tale of aromas, techniques and passion.



The tour continues in the Grappa and Gin distillery, the beating heart of the company, where the iconic Alexander and Bottega grappas are created. Here, the most advanced technology merges with the ancient art of distillation, in an almost alchemic process guided by the master distiller, the true guardian of poetic knowledge.



Guests are then welcomed in the “Prosecco Bar”, the first prototype of Bottega’s restaurant format, and accompanied to the “Barricaia” room, where the historic vintages of the finest products rest.



The visit continues in the 'Spices Room' and concludes in the Grappa Museum 'Art in Grappa', which houses a collection of Alexander blown glass bottles, true works of art that have featured in international exhibitions.
